CEDEC is delighted to announce a funding contribution from Quebec's [Canadian Relations Support Program \(CRSP\)](#) for the upcoming spring conference 'Creating Inclusive Economies: Building Bridges Between Public, Private and Civil Society Sectors' (CIE conference), co-hosted with the Canadian Rural Revitalization Foundation (CRRF).

The objective of the CRSP program is to increase knowledge and understanding of Québec elsewhere in Canada by supporting the development of ties between Quebecers and other Canadians.
